- Barukh ata Adonai Eloheynu, melekh ha-olam, Blessed are you, Lord our God, King of the universe
- Asher bechar banu mik-kol ha-am-mim venatan la-nu et Torato,
- Who chose us from all the people and gave us His Torah
- Baruch ata Adonai, no-tein Ha-Torah Blessed are you, Lord, giver of the Torah

Blessing over the reader of Torah

May He who blessed our fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob bless XXXXXXXXX because he has come up for the honor of God, for the honor of the Torah and for the honor of the Shabbat. In this merit may the Holy One, Blessed be He, protect and deliver XXXXX from all trouble and distress, from all affliction and illness, and may He send blessing and success to all his endeavors, together with all Israel and all his brethren; and the congregation says, In Yeshua's Name Amen.

Genesis 11:1 - 3

1 Now the entire earth had the same language with the same vocabulary.

2 When they traveled eastward, they found a valley-plain in the land of Shinar and settled there.

3 They said to one another, "Come! Let's make bricks and bake them until they're hard." So they used bricks for stone, and tar for mortar.

Genesis 11:4 - 6

4 Then they said, "Come! Let's build ourselves a city, with a tower whose top reaches into heaven. So let's make a name for ourselves, or else we will be scattered over the face of the whole land."

5 Then Yah came down to see the city and the tower that the sons of man had built.

6 Yah said, "Look, the people are one and all of them have the same language. So this is what they have begun to do. Now, nothing they plan to do will be impossible.

Genesis 11:7 - 9

7 Come! Let Us go down and confuse their language there, so that they will not understand each other's language."

- 8 So Adonai scattered them from there over the face of the entire land, and they stopped building the city.
- 9 This is why it is named Babel, because Adonai confused the languages of the entire world there, and from there Adonai scattered them over the face of the entire world.

Genesis 11:10 - 13

10 These are the genealogical records of Shem: Shem was 100 years old when he fathered Arpachshad—two years after the flood.

- 11 Shem lived 500 years after he fathered Arpachshad, and he fathered sons and daughters.
- 12 Arpachshad lived 35 years when he fathered Shelah.
- 13 Arpachshad lived 403 years after he fathered Shelah, and fathered sons and daughters.

Genesis 11:14 - 21

- 14 Shelah lived 30 years and he fathered Eber.
- 15 Shelah lived 403 years after he fathered Eber, and fathered sons and daughters.
- 16 Eber lived 34 years and he fathered Peleg.
- 17 Eber lived 430 years after he fathered Peleg, and he fathered sons and daughters.
- 18 Peleg lived 30 years and he fathered Reu.
- 19 Peleg lived 209 years after he fathered Reu, and he fathered sons and daughters.
- 20 Reu lived 32 years and he fathered Serug.
- 21 Reu lived 207 years after he fathered Serug, and he fathered sons and daughters.

Genesis 11:22 - 26

- 22 Serug lived 30 years and fathered Nahor.
- 23 Serug lived 200 years after he fathered Nahor, and he fathered sons and daughters.
- 24 Nahor lived 27 years and he fathered Terah.
- 25 Nahor lived 119 years after he fathered Terah, and he fathered sons and daughters.
- 26 Terah lived 70 years when he fathered Abram, Nahor and Haran.

Genesis 11:27 - 29

27 These are Terah's genealogies: Terah fathered Abram, Nahor and Haran. Haran fathered Lot.

28 Haran died before Terah his father, in the land of his birth, in Ur of the Chaldeans.

29 Abram and Nahor took wives for themselves. The name of Abram's wife was Sarai, and the name of Nahor's wife was Milcah—the daughter of Haran, father of Milcah and Iscah. 30 Sarai was barren; she did not have a child.

Genesis 11:31 - 32

31 Terah took Abram his son and Lot, Haran's son, his grandson, and Sarai his daughter-in-law, his son Abram's wife, and he took them out of Ur of the Chaldeans to go to the land of Canaan. But when they came to Haran, they settled there.

32 Terah's days were 205 years, and Terah died in Haran.



As In The Days Of Noah

Luke 17

26 As it was in the days of Noah, so will it also be in the days of the Son of Man.

Genesis 6:1 – 4 Parsha Bereshit

1 Now when humankind began to multiply on the face of the ground and daughters were born to them,

2 then the sons of God saw that the daughters of men were good and they took for themselves wives, any they chose.

3 Then YAH said, "*My Spirit will not remain with humankind forever, since they are flesh. So their days will be 120 years*.

4 The Nephilim were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, whenever the sons of God came to the daughters of men, and gave birth to them. Those were the mighty men of old, men of renown.

"My **Spirit will not remain** with humankind forever, since they are flesh"

Genesis 2:7 Then YHWH Elohim formed the man out of the dust from the ground and He breathed into his nostrils a **breath of life**—so the man became a living being.

And because man is so driven to do evil, The Spirit, the very Life, the Essence of YHWH, can not forever abide with them.

Ephesians 4:29-32

29 Let no harmful word come out of your mouth, but only what is beneficial for building others up according to the need, so that it gives grace to those who hear it.

30 Do not grieve the Ruach ha-Kodesh of Yah, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

31 Get rid of all bitterness and rage and anger and quarreling and slander, along with all malice.

32 Instead, be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving each other just as Yah in Messiah also forgave you.

Acts 7

51 "O you stiff-necked people! You uncircumcised of heart and ears! You always *resist the Ruach ha-Kodesh*; just as your fathers did, you do as well.

52 Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? They killed the ones who foretold the coming of the Righteous One. Now you have become His betrayers and murderers—

53 you who received the Torah by direction of angels and did not keep it!"

Genesis 6:5 – 8 Parsha Beresheit and Noach

5 Then YHWH saw that the wickedness of humankind was great on the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of their heart was only evil all the time.

6 So YHWH regretted that He made humankind on the earth, and His heart was deeply pained.

7 So YHWH said, "I will wipe out humankind, whom I have created, from the face of the ground, from humankind to livestock, crawling things and the flying creatures of the sky, because I regret that I made them."

8 But Noah found favor in YHWH's eyes.

Wages of Sin

Romans 6:23

For sin's payment is death, but Yah's gracious gift is eternal life in Messiah Yeshua our Lord.

Genesis 6:9 - 12

- 9 These are the genealogies of Noach. Noach was a righteous man. He was blameless among his generation. Noach continually walked with YHWH.
- 10 Noach fathered three sons: Shem, Ham and Japheth.
- 11 Now the earth was ruined before YHWH, and the earth was filled with violence.
- 12 YHWH saw the earth, and behold it was ruined because all flesh had corrupted their way upon the earth.

Genesis 6:13 - 16

13 Then YHWH said to Noah, "The end of all flesh is coming before Me, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. Behold, I am about to bring ruin upon them along with the land.

14 Make for yourself an ark of gopher wood. You shall make the ark with compartments and smear pitch on it, both inside and out.

15 Now this is how you shall make it: the length of the ark 300 cubits, its breadth 50 cubits, and its height 30 cubits.

16 You shall make a roof for the ark, and you shall finish it to within a cubit from the top. You shall put the door of the ark in its side. You shall make it with lower, second, and third stories.

Genesis 6:17 - 19

17 Now I am about to bring the flood—water upon the land—to destroy all flesh in which is the spirit of life from under the sky. Everything that is on the land will perish.

18 But I will establish My covenant with you. So you shall come into the ark—you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you.

19 Also of every living thing, of all flesh, you shall bring two of everything—male and female—into the ark to keep alive with you.

Genesis 6:20 - 22

20 Of the flying creatures according to their kind, of the livestock according to their kind, of all the crawling creatures of the ground according to their kind—two of everything will come to you to keep them alive.

21 As for you: take for yourself every kind of edible food and gather it to yourself. It will be food for you and for them."

22 So Noah did according to all that Yah commanded him; he did so exactly.

Noah Was Found To Be Righteous

Genesis 7

7 Then YHWH said to Noah, "Come you and all your household—into the ark. *For you only do I perceive as righteous before Me in this generation.*

Romans 4

1What then shall we say that Abraham, our forefather according to the flesh, has found?

2 For if Abraham was set right by works, he has something to boast about—but not before Yah.

3 For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham *believed* Yah, and it was credited to him as *righteousness*."

Romans 4

4 Now to the one who works, the pay is not credited as a gift, but as what is due.

5 But to the one who does not work, but trusts in Him who justifies the ungodly, his **trust** is credited as righteousness—

6 just as David also speaks of the blessing on the man to whom Yah credits righteousness apart from works:

Ecclesiastes 8

11 When the sentence against a crime is not swiftly carried out, the human heart is encouraged to do evil.

12 Even though a sinner might commit a hundred crimes and prolong his days, **yet I know that it will be well for those who fear Yah, for those who revere Him**.

13 But it will not go well with the wicked, and he will not lengthen his days like a shadow, because he does not fear YHWH.

Romans 4

7 "Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven and whose sins are covered.

8 Blessed is the man whose sin YHWH will never count against him."

9 Is this blessing then only on the circumcised, or also on the uncircumcised? For we say, *"trust was credited to Abraham as righteousness."*

Genesis 7:24 -8: 2

7:24 The waters overpowered the land for 150 days.

8:1 <u>Then Yah remembered Noah</u> and all the wild animals and all the livestock that were with him in the ark. So Yah caused a wind to pass over the land and the water subsided.

2 Also the sources of the deep and the windows of the skies were closed up, and the rain from the sky was held back.

Genesis 8:3 - 5

3 The waters kept receding gradually from upon the land and the waters decreased by the end of 150 days.

4 The ark came to rest in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat.

5 The waters went on decreasing until the tenth month. In the tenth month, on the first day of the month, the tops of the mountains appeared.

Total time in the Ark, nearly 371 days

Luke 17:23 - 27

23 They will say to you, 'Look, there!' or 'Look, here!' Do not go and chase after them.

24 For just as the lightning flashes from one part of the sky and lights up another part, so will the Son of Man be in His day.

25 But first He must suffer much and be rejected by this generation.

26 As it was in the days of Noah, so will it also be in the days of the Son of Man.

27 They were eating, drinking, marrying, and being given in marriage, until the day Noah entered the ark. Then the flood came and destroyed them all.

Hebrews 11

7 By faith Noah, when warned about events not yet seen, in holy fear prepared an ark for the safety of his household. Through faith he condemned the world and became an heir of the *righteousness that comes by faith*.

2 Peter 2

5 He (YHWH) did not spare the ancient world. He preserved only Noah, a proclaimer (preacher KJV) of righteousness, along with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the <u>ungodly</u>.

Luke 17:23 - 27

Luke 24:47

and in His name repentance and forgiveness of sins will be proclaimed to all nations, beginning in Jerusalem.

Acts 14:16

In past generations, He let all nations go their own way.

Acts 26:20

First to those in Damascus and Jerusalem, then to everyone in the region of Judea, and then to the Gentiles, I declared that they should repent and turn to God, performing deeds worthy of their repentance.

Acts 20:20 - 21

Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward Yah, and faith toward our Messiah, Yeshua HaMashiach.

Isaiah 11:2

1 Then a shoot will come forth out of the stem of Jesse, and a branch will bear fruit out of His roots
2 The Spirit of Yahweh will rest on him: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the *fear of Yahweh*.

2 Corinthians 3:17 Now YHWH is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of YHWH is, there is liberty. 2 Corinthians 3:17
