1 Then YHWH spoke to Moshe saying,

² "On the first day of the first month, you will set up the Tabernacle of the Tent of Meeting.

³ You are to put the Ark of the Testimony there, and screen off the Ark with the curtain.

⁴Then bring in the table, and set in order the bread that is on it. Bring in the *menorah* and light its lamps.

⁵ Set the golden incense altar in front of the Ark of the Testimony, and hang the curtain over the entrance of the Tabernacle.

⁶ "Set the altar of burnt offering before the entrance of the Tabernacle, the Tent of Meeting.

⁷ Set up the basin between the Tent of Meeting and the altar, and put water in it.

⁸ Set up the courtyard all around, and hang the curtain of the gate of the courtyard.

⁹ "Take the anointing oil and anoint the Tabernacle, and everything within it, and consecrate it, along with all of its furnishings, and it will be holy.

10 Also you are to anoint the altar of burnt offering with all of its utensils and consecrate the altar. The altar will be most holy.

¹¹ Then you are to anoint the basin along with its base and sanctify it.

¹² "Bring Aaron and his sons to the entrance of the Tent of Meeting, and wash them with water.

13 Put the holy garments on Aaron, anoint him and consecrate him, so that he may minister to Me as a kohen.

14 Also bring his sons and put tunics upon them.

15 You are to anoint them, as you did their father, so that they too may minister to Me as kohanim. Their anointing will be for an everlasting priesthood throughout their generations."

¹⁶ Moshe did so, just as YHWH had commanded him.

¹⁷ Now it happened during the first month of the second year, on the first day of the month, the Tabernacle was raised up.

¹⁸ Moses raised the Tabernacle, and laid its bases, set up the framework of boards, put in the crossbars and set up its pillars.

¹⁹ Then he spread the tent over the Tabernacle and put the covering of the tent on it, just as *YHWH* had commanded Moses.

²⁰ He placed the Testimony into the Ark, set the poles on the Ark, and put the atonement cover on top of the Ark.

21 He brought the Ark into the Tabernacle, set up the curtain as a screen, and screened off the Ark of the Testimony, just as YHWH had commanded Moses.

22 Then he set up the table inside the Tent of Meeting, on the side of the Tabernacle northward, outside the curtain.

23 He set a row of bread in order upon it before YHWH, just as YHWH had commanded Moses.

24 Then he placed the menorah in the Tent of Meeting, over against the table, on the south side of the Tabernacle.

25 Then he lit the lamps before YHWH, just as YHWH had commanded Moses.

²⁶ Next he placed the golden altar in the Tent of Meeting before the curtain,

²⁷ and he burned sweet spices of incense there, just as *YHWH* had commanded Moshe.

- ²⁸ He hung the curtain over the entrance of the Tabernacle.
- ²⁹ Then he set the altar of burnt offering at the entrance of the Tabernacle, the Tent of Meeting, and offered upon it the burnt offering and the grain offering, just as YHWH had commanded Moses.
- Next he set up the basin between the Tent of Meeting and the altar and put water in it for washing,

³¹ so that Moshe, Aaron and his sons could wash their hands and their feet there.

When they went into the Tent of Meeting and when they came near to the altar, they washed, just as YHWH had commanded Moses.

³³ He set up the courtyard around the Tabernacle and the altar and set up the screen at the gate of the courtyard. So Moses finished the work.


³⁴ Then the cloud covered the Tent of Meeting, and the glory of *YHWH* filled the Tabernacle.

³⁵ Moses was unable to enter into the Tent of Meeting, because the cloud resided there and the glory of *YHWH* filled the Tabernacle.

36 Now whenever the cloud was taken up from over the Tabernacle, Bnei-Yisrael went onward, throughout all their journeys.

³⁷ But if the cloud was not taken up, then they did not move out until the day that it was.

³⁸ For the cloud of *YHWH* was on the Tabernacle by day and a fire was there by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel throughout all their journeys.



Accountability

Exodus 38

These are the accounts of the Tabernacle of the Testimony, as they were recorded according to the commandment of Moses, by the service of the Levites, under the hand of Ithamar son of Aaron the *kohen*.

- ²¹ He brought the Ark into the Tabernacle, set up the curtain as a screen, and screened off the Ark of the Testimony, just as *YHWH* had commanded Moses.
- ²² Then he set up the table inside the Tent of Meeting, on the side of the Tabernacle northward, outside the curtain.
- ²³ He set a row of bread in order upon it before *Adonai*, just as *YHWH* had commanded Moses.
- ²⁴ Then he placed the *menorah* in the Tent of Meeting, over against the table, on the south side of the Tabernacle.
- ²⁵ Then he lit the lamps before *YHWH*, just as *YHWH* had commanded Moses.

Acts 17

²⁴ The Elohim who made the world and all things in it, since He is Elohim of heaven and earth, does not live in temples made by hands.

²⁵ Nor is He served by human hands, as if He needed anything, since He Himself gives to everyone life and breath and all things.

Our Hope And Promise

Ezekiel 36

24 "For I will take you from the nations, gather you out of all the countries and bring you back to your own land.

25 Then I will sprinkle clean water on you and you will be clean from all your uncleanness and from all your idols.

¹⁵ Then the Judean leaders were amazed, saying, "How does this man know so much, having never been taught?"

¹⁶ Yeshua answered, "My teaching is not from Me, but from Him who sent Me.

What Instructions Do We Hear?

John 7

17 If anyone wants to do His will, he will know whether My teaching comes from YHWH or it is Myself speaking.

18 Whoever speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who seeks the glory of the One who sent Him, He is true and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

19 Hasn't Moses given you the Torah? Yet none of you keeps it. Why are you trying to kill Me?"

What Instructions Do We Hear And Follow?

John 16:28

I came forth from the Father and have come into the world; I am leaving the world again and going to the Father."

John 6:38

For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

John 14:31

but so that the world may know that I love the Father, I do exactly as the Father commanded Me. Get up, let us go from here.

John 5:19

Therefore Yeshua answered and was saying to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, unless it is something He sees the Father doing; for whatever the Father does, these things the Son also does in like manner.

Accountability

Luke 14

²⁸ "For which of you, wanting to build a tower, doesn't first sit down and figure out the cost, to see if he has enough to finish it?

²⁹ Otherwise, when he has laid a foundation and isn't able to finish everything, all who see it begin to mock him,

³⁰ saying, 'This man began to build and wasn't able to finish!'

Furnishing Your Temple

Matthew 12

⁴³ "Now when an unclean spirit goes out of a man, it passes through waterless places looking for rest and doesn't find it.

⁴⁴ Then it says, 'I'll go back home where I came from.' And when it comes, it finds the house vacant, swept clean, and put in order.

⁴⁵ Then it goes and brings along seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they go in and live there. And that man's last condition becomes worse than the first. So also will it be for this evil generation."

16 The Ruach Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of YHWH.

17 And if children, also heirs—heirs of YHWH and joint-heirs with Messiah—if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

The Ruach Guides Us

Romans 8

25 But if we hope for what we do not see, then we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.

26 In the same way, the Ruach helps in our weakness. For we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Ruach Himself intercedes for us with groans too deep for words.

27 And He who searches the hearts knows the mind of the Ruach, because He intercedes for the kedoshim according to the will of YHWH.

The Ruach Changes Us

Titus 3

1 Remind the people to be submitted to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good deed,

2 to slander no one, without fighting, gentle, showing every courtesy to all people.

3 For we also once were foolish, disobedient, deluded, enslaved to various desires and pleasures, spending our lives in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another.

The Ruach Changes Us

Titus 3

4 But when the kindness of YHWH our Savior and His love for mankind appeared—

5 not by deeds of righteousness which we had done ourselves, but because of His mercy— He saved us through the mikveh of rebirth and renewing of the Ruach ha-Kodesh,

6 whom He abundantly poured out on us through Messiah Yeshua our Savior,

7 so that being set right by His grace, we might become heirs with the confident hope of eternal life!

The Ruach Changes Us

Titus 3

8 Trustworthy is the saying, and I want you to insist on these things, so that those who have put their trust in YHWH may be careful to devote themselves to good deeds. These things are good and beneficial for people.

9 But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and strife and disputes about Torah, for they are unprofitable and useless.

10 Dismiss a quarrelsome person after a first and second warning,

11 knowing that such a person is twisted and is sinning—he is self-condemned.

One Ruach, Many Attributes

- 1 Corinthians 12
- 4 Now there are various kinds of gifts, but the same Ruach.

5 There are various kinds of service, but the same Lord.

6 There are various kinds of working, but the same God who works all things in all people.

7 But to each person is given the manifestation of the Ruach for the benefit of all.

One Ruach, Many Gifts

- 1 Corinthians 12
- 8 For to one is given through the Ruach a word of wisdom, to another a word of knowledge according to the same Ruach,

9 to another faith by the same Ruach, to another gifts of healings by the one Ruach,

10 to another workings of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.

One Ruach, Many Attributes

1 Corinthians 12

11 But one and the same Ruach activates all these things, distributing to each person individually as He wills.

12 For just as the body is one and has many parts, and all the parts of the body—though many—are one body, so also is Messiah.

13 For in one Ruach we were all immersed into one body—whether Jewish or Greek, slave or free—and all were made to drink of one Ruach.

Seeing Change Through The Ruach

2 Corinthians 5

¹⁶ So from now on we recognize no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Messiah according to the flesh, yet now we no longer know Him this way.

¹⁷ Therefore if anyone is in Messiah, he is a new creation. The old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

¹⁸ Now all these things are from YHWH, who reconciled us to Himself through Messiah and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.

¹⁹ That is, in Messiah YHWH was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them; and He has entrusted the message of reconciliation to us.
