

# The Three Pilgrimage Feasts

## Deuteronomy 16

16 Three times a year all your males are to appear before Adonai your God in the place He chooses—at the Feast of Matzot, the Feast of Shavuot, and the Feast of Sukkot. No one should appear before Adonai empty-handed—

17 the gift of each man's hand according to the blessing Adonai your God has given you.

# The Three Pilgrimage Feasts

## Zechariah 14

16 Then all the survivors from all the nations that attacked Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, Adonai-Tzva'ot, and to celebrate Sukkot.

17 Furthermore, if any of the nations on earth do not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, YHWH-Tzva'ot, they will have no rain.

18 If the Egyptians do not go up and celebrate, they will have no rain. Instead, there will be the plague that Adonai will inflict on the nations that do not go up to celebrate Sukkot.

19 This will be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not go up to celebrate Sukkot.

# Drawing Of The Water

## John 7

1 After these events, Yeshua was walking about in the Galilee. He did not want to walk in Judea, because the Judean leaders wanted to kill Him.

2 Now the Jewish Feast of Tabernacles was near.

3 Therefore His brothers said to Him, "Leave here and go to Judea, so Your disciples also may see the works You are doing.

4 No one who wants to be well known does everything in secret. If You are doing these things, show Yourself to the world!"

5 For not even His brothers were trusting in Him.

# Rivers Of Living Water

John 7

37 On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Yeshua stood up and cried out loudly, **“If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink.**

**38 Whoever believes in Me, as the Scripture says, ‘out of his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.’”**

39 Now He said this about the Ruach, whom those who trusted in Him were going to receive; for the Ruach was not yet given, since Yeshua was not yet glorified.

# Who Is This Man?

## John 7

40 When they heard these words, some of the crowd said, “This man really is the Prophet.”

41 Others were saying, “This is the Messiah.” Still others were saying, “The Messiah doesn’t come from the Galilee, does He?”

42 Didn’t the Scripture say that the Messiah comes from the seed of David and from Bethlehem, David’s town?”

43 So a division arose in the crowd because of Yeshua.

44 Some wanted to capture Him, but no one laid hands on Him.

# Redemption from Galilee

## Isaiah 9

1 Nevertheless, there will be no more gloom for those who were in distress. In the past he humbled the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the future he will honor Galilee of the nations, by the Way of the Sea, beyond the Jordan—

2 The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of deep darkness a light has dawned.

3 You have enlarged the nation and increased their joy; they rejoice before you as people rejoice at the harvest, as warriors rejoice when dividing the plunder.

# Living Water

Isaiah 44:3 For I will pour water on the thirsty land and streams on the dry ground. I will pour My Spirit on your offspring, and My blessing on your descendants.

Isaiah 55:1 “Come, everyone who thirsts, come to the water, and you who have no money, come, buy and eat.

Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost!



# Living Water

## Isaiah 12

2 Behold, Yah is my salvation! I will trust and will not be afraid. For the Lord Yah is my strength and my song. He also has become my salvation.”

3 With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

# Living Waters

Isaiah 58:11 Then Yah will guide you continually, satisfy your soul in drought and strengthen your bones. You will be like a watered garden, like a spring of water whose waters never fail.

Zechariah 14:8 Moreover, in that day living waters will flow from Jerusalem, half toward the eastern sea and half toward the western sea, both in the summer and in the winter.

9 Adonai will then be King over all the earth. In that day Adonai will be Echad and His Name Echad.

# Waving The Palm Branches – The Four kinds

## Revelations 7

9 After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands,

10 and crying out with a loud voice, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!”

7 The one who overcomes shall inherit these things, and I will be his Elohim and he shall be My son.

8 But for the cowardly and faithless and detestable and murderers and sexually immoral and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars—their lot is in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.”

## Matthew 24

29 “But immediately after the trouble of those days, ‘the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light and the stars will fall from heaven and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.’

30 Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the land will mourn, and they will see ‘the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven’ with power and great glory.

31 He will send out His angels with a great shofar, and they will gather together His chosen from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.”
